**LOCAL MAGNETIC ANOMALIES**  
 Local magnetic anomalies are indicated by a small circle with the letters 'MA' inside. They are derived from the magnetic field data collected by the British Hydrographic Survey.

**TIDAL STREAMS**  
 Tidal streams are indicated by a small circle with the letters 'TS' inside. They are derived from the tidal stream data collected by the British Hydrographic Survey.
